
The following contains instructions to join a WebEx event hosted by the Department of Consumer Affairs (DCA).



2. The details of the event are presented on the left of the screen and the required information for you to complete is on the right.






3. Click the 'Join Now' button.

NOTE: The event password will be entered automatically. If you alter the password by accident, close the browser and click the event link provided again.

4. If you do not have the WebEx applet installed for your browser, a new window may open, so make sure your pop-up blocker is disabled. You may see a window asking you to open or run new software. Click 'Run'.



Depending on your computer's settings, you may be blocked from running the necessary software. If this is the case, click 'Cancel' and return to the browser tab that looks like the window below. You can bypass the above process.

- 6. A dialog box will appear at the bottom of the page, click 'Run'.




The temporary software will run, and the meeting window will open.

7. Click the audio menu below the green 'Join Event' button.







8. When the audio menu appears click 'Call in'.




If you join the meeting using your computer's microphone and audio, or you didn't connect audio at all, you can still set that up while you are in the meeting.

The 'Call In' information can be displayed by selecting 'Call in' then 'View'




You will then be presented the dial in information for you to call in from any phone.



Participating During a Public Comment Period


At certain times during the event, the facilitator may call for public comment. If you would like to make a public comment, click on the 'Q and A' button near the bottom, center of your WebEx session.

Subject: 2021 Rulemaking Calendar

Purpose:

To introduce the proposed 2021 Rulemaking Calendar.

Background:

Government Code (GC) § 11017.6 requires all agencies annually submit a calendar of anticipated regulatory changes and the timeframe in which they expect to submit those changes. This allows OAL to prepare for anticipated workload in the coming year. Therefore, at each November meeting, the Board adopts a proposed Rulemaking Calendar. The Rulemaking Calendar prepared pursuant to this section sets forth the Board's rulemaking plan for the year and is published by the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) in the California Regulatory Notice Register (Notice Register); the Notice Register is available on OAL's website: https://oal.ca.gov/publications/notice register/

Board staff has been reviewing all regulations under Division 13.2 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations to identify regulations in need of amending or repealing. From this review, staff is proposing the attached rulemaking to be added to the 2021 Rulemaking Calendar.
