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PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



President Karen Brandon

Have you ever watched a Senate confirmation hearing or a joint committee investigation on television or online? The individuals presenting often arrive with thick binders, extensive briefing materials, and countless hours of preparation, yet they still do not know every question that may be asked or whether they have anticipated every concern. Every detail can be questioned, requested, expected, and inspected. I had the privilege of participating with our Executive Officer, Jason Kaiser, and our Vice President, Dr. Dayle Armstrong, Physical Therapist, in presenting the culmination of years of preparation and progress in the Joint Committee Hearing Room on March 10, 2026.

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For physical therapists, it feels surprisingly familiar. In many ways, the California Sunset Review process resembles a high-stakes version of our own lab practicals and national board examinations. Preparation matters, knowledge matters, transparency matters — but equally important is the ability to demonstrate competence, accountability, judgment, and public trust under scrutiny. Each board that goes through this process has to keep in mind the big picture—their mission and charge.

Every four years, California regulatory boards undergo this comprehensive legislative review process to evaluate whether they are effectively fulfilling their mission and whether continuation of the Board remains warranted. This is not an automatic process. It is a thorough evaluation of the Board's fiscal responsibility, operational effectiveness, responsiveness to stakeholders, and commitment to protecting the public. Following the PTBC's Sunset Report review and hearing, the Assembly Business and Professions Committee introduced AB 2774. The bill, which is currently moving through the regular legislative process, proposes to extend the Board's statutory authority to regulate the physical therapy profession.

As President of the Physical Therapy Board of California (PTBC), and as someone who has spent decades as both a clinician and educator, I believe this process is critically important. Physical therapy continues to evolve rapidly. Our workforce is expanding, educational preparation has deepened, specialty practice areas continue to emerge, and innovation in rehabilitation science, technology, and interdisciplinary care is accelerating. Regulation must evolve thoughtfully alongside these changes.

Since the last Sunset Review in 2021, the profession and healthcare environment have evolved rapidly. This year's review focused on evaluating licensure fee structures, strengthening alignment between public protection standards and disciplinary procedures in cases of gross provider misconduct, and realigning budgetary resources to improve enforcement processing and operational efficiency.

The Sunset Review process allows legislators and stakeholders to evaluate whether the PTBC's systems are functioning effectively, including whether fee structures remain fair and sustainable, whether staffing levels adequately support the PTBC's responsibilities, and whether licensing applications and consumer complaints are managed efficiently, consistently, and transparently.

Most importantly, this process centers on public protection. Californians deserve confidence that the physical therapists and physical therapist assistants caring for them are vetted, qualified, competent, and held to professional and ethical standards. The PTBC's role is not simply administrative; it is foundational to maintaining public trust in our profession.

Thoughtful oversight and strong checks and balances are not barriers to professional growth or innovation. They are part of what allows progress to occur responsibly, ethically, and sustainably for the people we serve. The passing of AB 2774 allows the sun to continue shining on a profession committed to advancing health, sustaining quality care, and protecting the public for the next four years.

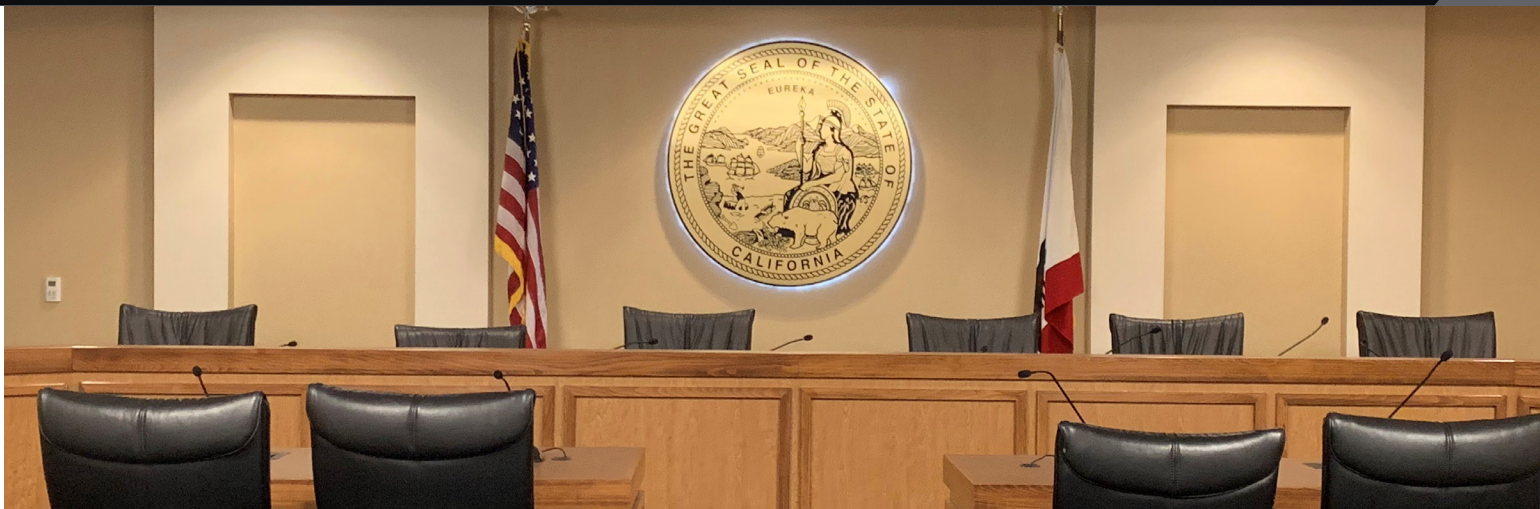
The Board convenes public meetings to conduct the business of PTBC, make regulatory and enforcement decisions, and address other issues within their jurisdiction.

Continuing competency hours may be awarded for attending Board meetings in person to encourage

physical therapists and physical therapist assistants to learn more about the issues and operations of the PTBC.

Who is the Physical Therapy Board of California (PTBC)?

The Physical Therapy Board of California (PTBC) is a government agency within the Department of Consumer Affairs. PTBC licenses and disciplines physical therapists and physical therapist assistants. The PTBC provides three principal types of consumer services: verifies education and background prior to licensure, provides information about the practice of physical therapy by physical therapists and physical therapist assistants, and investigates complaints against physical therapists and physical therapist assistants.

Board Meetings

Board meetings are mandated to three board meetings a year. Typically, the PTBC conducts four meetings a year in the areas of Northern and Southern California. Board meetings are usually two days long and the public is highly encouraged to attend.

Benefits of Hosting a Board Meeting

- Consumers in the area can be educated on the practice of physical therapy.
- Licensees in the area can attend and receive continuing competency credit while having their voices heard on topics being discussed.
- Students and applicants can attend in between classes and learn how PTBC operates and how decisions are made that affect the profession.
- Name recognition for the hosting location.

DO WE HAVE YOUR EMAIL ADDRESS?

Licensees are required to provide the Physical Therapy Board of California (PTBC) with an email address if the licensee has one. Email is an efficient conduit for sharing information between PTBC and its applicants and licensees. PTBC will be able to communicate regarding the status of applications, renewals, and requests for various PTBC services; provide law and regulation updates; and disseminate important PTBC news directly to each applicant and licensee—from the PTBC to your door (or email inbox). It doesn't get much easier! The PTBC hopes this accelerated delivery and exchange of information will

decrease processing times in all aspects of PTBC's programs and facilitate licensees keeping apprised of laws and regulations and PTBC activities. Moreover, with the transition to the BreEZe system, email will be the standard method of communication. You can submit/update your email address using BreEZe or submit your address change with BreEZe. You may also submit your email address in writing to the PTBC—please include your name and license number.



CONTINUING COMPETENCY REQUIREMENTS

The Physical Therapy Board of California (PTBC) is responsible for protecting consumers by ensuring safe and effective physical therapy practice. As the practice of physical therapy continues to evolve, Physical Therapists (PTs) and Physical Therapist Assistants (PTAs) are expected to keep their knowledge and skills up to date. Continuing competency supports this by promoting ongoing learning and professional development throughout a licensee's career.

Continuing competency requirements are the same for both PTs and PTAs. If you recently received your license and have not yet renewed for the first time, you are in your initial license period and must complete 15 hours of continuing competency (CC). For all other licensees, the requirement is 30 hours. Please note that only hours earned during the renewal cycle count toward renewal requirements.

There are two subject matter requirements that must be completed during each renewal cycle. Licensees must complete two hours in ethics, laws and regulations and four hours in life support for health care professionals. The life support course must be comparable to or more advanced than the American Heart Association's Basic Life Support (BLS) Health Care Provider course and include an in-person, hands-on component.

To complete your remaining hours, you have several options. The most common way to earn CC hours is through PTBC-recognized Approval Agencies, which are listed on the Continuing Competency webpage of the PTBC website. These agencies approve courses for California licensees, as the PTBC does not directly approve or review CC courses. If the provider of a course is not a PTBC-recognized Approval Agency or an approved provider of an Approval Agency, the hours generally will not count toward renewal requirements.

There are also opportunities to earn CC hours through alternate pathways, which allow licensees to receive credit for professional activities beyond traditional coursework. These pathways include,

but are not limited to, performing in a role as a clinical instructor, publishing a peer-reviewed journal article, and attending a PTBC board meeting (participation encouraged but not required!). Each alternate pathway has a designated number of hours associated with it and can also be found on the Continuing Competency webpage.

Finally, licensees who complete college coursework during a renewal cycle may be able to apply those hours toward their CC requirements, provided the coursework is related to the practice of physical therapy and offered through an accredited institution.

What if you complete a course and later discover that it does not qualify for CC hours? All is not lost. In some cases, retroactive approval may be an option. Retroactive approval is the process by which PTBC-recognized Approval Agencies evaluate courses that have already been completed but were not previously approved for California licensees. If the course meets continuing competency standards, the agency may approve the course and assign appropriate CC hours.

A common question at renewal time is, "Where do I submit my certificates of CC completion?" The good news is that you don't need to submit them unless you're selected for audit. The PTBC regularly selects random samples of licensees and audits their CC hours for compliance. Be sure to retain course completion records for at least five years and keep them easily accessible. If selected for audit, having your documentation organized and ready will make the process much smoother, and your PTBC auditors will definitely appreciate it.

Continuing competency plays an important role in supporting lifelong learning in the physical therapy profession. By staying familiar with the requirements and planning ahead each renewal cycle, licensees can remain compliant while continuing to develop their knowledge and skills. PROGRAM SPOTLIGHT: LOMA LINDA UNIVERSITY



Loma Linda University's PT program was initially accredited by the Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE) in 1942, and its PTA program was first accredited in 1990. Loma Linda is unique in that they offer both a PT and a PTA program. For the years 2023 and 2024 Loma Linda, on average, had a first-time licensure pass rate of 87.1%. For 2024 and 2025, Loma Linda's average graduation rate was 93.7%. For 2023 and 2024, Loma Linda had an employment rate of 100%

The PTBC has been invited multiple times to Loma Linda to provide a two-hour workshop that reviews laws and regulations, a step-by-step presentation on how to apply for licensure, Physical Therapy License Applicants (PTLA) status, and continuing competency requirements. Staff also explains the differences between the PTBC's mandate of consumer protection and other organizations, such as the California Physical Therapy Association (CPTA), that advocates for the profession of physical therapy.

During and after each presentation, there is a Q&A session in which students can ask PTBC staff anything they want to know about their road to licensure or the laws and regulations surrounding the profession. This gives the students an opportunity to gain a better understanding of the Physical Therapy Practice Act and more information on what is needed to apply for licensure as well as what happens after they are licensed.

CANCELLED LICENSE? WHAT TO DO NOW?

When a physical therapist (PT) or physical therapist assistant (PTA) experiences a career change, relocates to another state or country, or finds renewal requirements financially burdensome, they may allow their license to lapse and become delinquent. After five consecutive years of non renewal, a delinquent license is cancelled. The Physical Therapy Board of California (PTBC) does not offer a reinstatement pathway, so former licensees who wish to practice in California again must apply for a new PT or PTA license.

How to Reapply

To reapply, follow the endorsement application process at ptbc.ca.gov. Begin by creating a BreEZe account. If you previously held a BreEZe account for your cancelled license, you may use the same account to submit your new application. BreEZe allows access to the online application and, once your new license is issued, offers faster online renewal compared to renewing by mail.

Although retaking the National Physical Therapy Examination (NPTE/NPTAE) is not required, applicants must pass the California Laws and Regulations Exam (CAL JAM), an online jurisprudence assessment module. Registration is completed at FSBPT.org. The CAL JAM fee is \$50, and the exam must be taken within 96 hours of receiving your Authorization to Test (ATT). Taking the CAL JAM prior to submitting your application is recommended.

Before accessing the online application, ensure you have a digital copy of a color passport-style photo taken within the last 30 days. Applicants must also complete a fingerprint based background check. The application includes questions to help you determine whether to submit fingerprints via hard card or California LiveScan. California residents are required to use LiveScan services.

Tips to Help Prevent Your License from Lapsing

- Add your license expiration date to your calendar and set reminders 90 days and 30 days before renewal.
- Keep your BreEZe email address current so you receive renewal notices and Board communications.
- Renew online through BreEZe for faster processing and fewer delays.
- Maintain continuing competency activities throughout your renewal cycle to avoid last minute pressure.
- Plan financially for renewal fees by setting aside funds during the two year cycle.
- Update your mailing address promptly if you move.
- If you are unsure about future practice plans, consider keeping your license active—staying current is far simpler than reapplying after cancellation.

STAFF SPOTLIGHT: ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES EDITION

BROOKE ARNESON

Joining the PTBC in 2014, Brooke Arneson is a key leader as Policy Manager, guiding the development and implementation of Board policies. Her sharp analytical skills and ability to translate complex legal language into clear, actionable information ensure effective governance and focus on consumer protection. Through Brooke's initiative and efforts, Board members and stakeholders consistently receive timely updates on legislative and regulatory changes. Her commitment to collaboration, adaptability, and follow-through actively supports the ongoing success of the PTBC team.

Q: How long have you been with PTBC?

I have been with the PTBC since 2014.

Q: Where did you work before coming to work for the PTBC?

Before joining the PTBC, I worked in both the private and public sectors. I began in the private sector with The Princeton Review, where I served as an Executive Director overseeing operations, program delivery, and regional strategy. I later transitioned into state service at the Department of General Services, working in their HR and Fiscal units, and eventually served as a Budget Manager for CalSTRS. Those roles gave me a strong foundation in statewide operations, workforce management, and fiscal planning; experience that continues to support my work in legislative and regulatory policy today.

Q: If you did not work at the PTBC, what would you be doing?

If I weren't at the PTBC, I'd still be in the public sector. I really value work that strengthens systems and directly serves Californians, so I'd likely be in another regulatory board or a legislative office doing similar policy work. Public service has always felt meaningful to me, and I'd want to stay in a role where I can help shape direction and support programs that make a real difference.

Q: Walk me through your day at work.

My day usually shifts between looking at new legislation, helping shape policy direction, working on regulations, and coordinating with different partners. I spend a lot of time reviewing bills, breaking down what they mean for the Board, tracking changes, and making sure we clearly communicate how they would affect our work. I also work closely with Board leadership, DCA, and other stakeholders to guide policy discussions, keep our regulatory projects moving, and make sure our materials, like briefings, talking points, and bill or fiscal analyses are accurate, timely, and ready for Board or legislative use.

Q: What do you find the most rewarding about what you do?

The most rewarding part is seeing how our work directly strengthens consumer protection. When a bill is improved because we identify an operational or enforcement gap, or when a regulation increases clarity and safety for the public, it's a clear reminder that our work has real impact.

Q: What is the most difficult part of your job?

The most challenging aspect is balancing the pace of the legislative process with the operational realities of a statewide licensing and enforcement program. Bills can move quickly, and ensuring our analyses are both timely and thorough requires constant coordination and strategic prioritization.

Q: What do you like to do on your days off?

On my days off, I focus on resetting, spending time with my family, keeping up with my two young kids, cooking, Pilates, and making space for the things that help me recharge, so I return to the work clear and focused.

Q: What does consumer protection mean to you?

Consumer protection means ensuring Californians can trust the professionals who provide their care. For PTBC, that includes maintaining rigorous licensing standards, supporting strong

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enforcement authority, and ensuring our policies and regulations reflect current practice and public expectations. It's about safeguarding the public while supporting a profession that plays a critical role in health and mobility.

VINCENT AZAR

Vincent Azar joined PTBC in 2013 and has experience across all units. Currently, as the Information Technology Liaison and Process Improvement Analyst, he leverages his expertise to develop technology-focused operational solutions tailored to PTBC's specific business needs. He is continuously seeking opportunities for innovation to advance the PTBC's mission. Vincent is recognized by his colleagues as a trusted resource, consistently providing creative strategies, clear and thoughtful guidance, and support through technology and process changes.

Q: How long have you been with PTBC?

I have been with the Physical Therapy Board of California since May 2013. Over that time, I have had the opportunity to work in several roles and support different areas of the organization, which has given me a broad understanding of how the Board operates.

Q: Where did you work before coming to work for the PTBC?

Before joining PTBC, I worked part time at In-N-Out while also doing administrative work for a family business. That experience gave me early exposure to both customer service and office operations, which helped shape the way I approach problem solving and supporting others in my work today.

Q: If you did not work at the PTBC, what would you be doing?

Q: Walk me through your day at work.

My day typically involves monitoring incoming PTBC IT requests, assisting staff with technical issues, supporting ADA compliance needs, and developing systems that help improve efficiency across our operations. I spend a good amount of

time building tools and workflows that streamline processes and reduce manual work for staff. I also collaborate with staff across multiple units and participate in meetings to support projects and ongoing operational needs.

Q: What do you find the most rewarding about what you do?

The most rewarding part of my work is developing IT solutions that streamline processes and improve efficiency. I enjoy identifying opportunities to improve the way we work and building systems that help staff complete tasks more easily and consistently. I like knowing that what I do often either makes other people's jobs easier or strengthens our data integrity. Hearing feedback from staff that a system or tool I developed has made their day-to-day work smoother is especially rewarding.

Q: What is the most difficult part of your job?

One of the most challenging parts of my job is determining system requirements and translating staff's non-technical descriptions of a problem or need into a practical technical solution. This often involves asking the right questions, understanding the underlying process, and designing a system that meets operational needs while working within existing technical constraints. While it can be challenging, it is also an important part of building solutions that truly support staff and improve workflows.

It involves maintaining strong systems, clear processes, and reliable data so that the Board can effectively carry out its responsibility to protect the public. In my role, that means supporting the tools and systems staff rely on so decisions are based on accurate information and the Board's work is carried out efficiently and responsibly.

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: WHEN AND HOW TO REPORT ARRESTS OR CONVICTIONS

We at the Physical Therapy Board of California (PTBC) know that our licensees have a deep appreciation for the responsibility given when a patient entrusts you with the next step in their rehabilitation journey. You want to be the best Physical Therapist or Physical Therapist Assistant you can be. You read, you train, you treat, and you document to the point that these actions become second nature. You know that a mistake can have repercussions that reach far into the future, affecting you, your patient, and everyone that cares for them. This appreciation for the responsibilities we uphold is a driving force in the Board's mission, and like you, we dedicate ample time and effort to ensure that our licensees are skilled, educated, and aware of the laws governing the practice of physical therapy in the state of California.

With this in mind, the Board would like to remind our licensees that as a licensed physical therapist and physical therapist assistant, your conduct falls under multiple overlapping jurisdictions of administrative and criminal law, and, while we know that none of our licensees ever intend to get arrested, it does happen, so it's important to know what your responsibilities are to the PTBC when multiple layers of law come in to play after an arrest.

The days following an arrest tend to be worrisome. Stress can produce an overwhelming urge to keep any information related to that arrest to yourself until you have resolved your case in court, however; we must remind our licensees about the requirements set forth by California Code of Regulations Section 1399.24(d), which states:

In addition to the conduct described in Section 2660 of the Code, "unprofessional conduct" also includes, but is not limited to the following:

- (d) *Failure to report to the board within 30 days any of the following:*
- (1) *The bringing of an indictment or information charging a felony against the licensee.*
 - (2) *The arrest of the licensee.*



- (3) *The conviction of the licensee, including any verdict of guilty, or pleas of guilty or no contest, of any felony or misdemeanor.*
- (4) *Any disciplinary action taken by another licensing entity or authority of this state or of another state or an agency of the federal government or the United States military.*
- (5) *Any report required to be made pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 802 regarding settlements, judgments, or arbitration awards.*

Since we share a responsibility of public/consumer protection, it is necessary for the PTBC to investigate any arrest of a licensee and may consider a failure to disclose an arrest or conviction within the required thirty days an act of unprofessional conduct to be considered along with the investigation of the arrest or conviction. We want to prevent this from happening, so we would also like to remind our licensees that there are several different ways to disclose an arrest or conviction to the PTBC.

First, you'll want to gather the relevant information to disclose if it is available, including the date of your arrest, the name of the arresting agency, the court jurisdiction your case will be adjudicated in, and the court case number if it is available to you. Once you have this information, you have several options on how to inform the PTBC:

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1. **By e-mail:** You may disclose your arrest information by sending an e-mail to the Consumer Protection Services inbox at CPS@dca.ca.gov.
2. **By mail:** You may send a written disclosure to PTBC's mailing address at 2005 Evergreen Street, Suite 2600, Sacramento, CA 95815.
3. If you renew your license within thirty days of an arrest or conviction, you may disclose this information on your PTBC license renewal application.

Once received, licensees will have satisfied the California Code of Regulation's disclosure requirement and can expect to receive further communication from our analysts as the PTBC investigation progresses.

Whatever the outcome of your criminal matter, reporting and providing information promptly facilitates timely consideration of our administrative investigation. PTBC HAS ELIMINATED THE POCKET LICENSE!

The Physical Therapy Board of California (PTBC) has made license verification more effective and efficient for consumers and licensees. Effective July 2020, the PTBC no longer issues pocket licenses upon initial licensure or renewal. Pocket licenses may not reflect a licensee's current status, as it may change within the 2-year license period, and they do not display enforcement action taken against a license, if any. Current license status and enforcement action information are available on Department of Consumer Affairs (DCA) License Search, an online license verification system. Consumers, employers, or any interested party can access license information online 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. You can access the DCA License Search system on the home page of the PTBC [website](http://www.ptbc.ca.gov).

SUBSTANCE ABUSE REHABILITATION HOTLINE

Physical therapists (PTs) and physical therapist assistants (PTAs) are not immune from the diseases of chemical dependency. Experts estimate that at least 10% of the general population will have a problem with alcohol or drugs at some point in their lives. Health care professionals, including PTs and PTAs, may be particularly susceptible to substance abuse problems due to the stresses of working in a health care environment and due to an increased opportunity to obtain controlled substances.

Many PTs and PTAs who experience problems with chemical dependency can find the help and support they need without involvement from PTBC.

If chemical dependency problems are left untreated, they may eventually jeopardize patient health and safety. They can also threaten the life of the person afflicted.

In these cases, it becomes imperative that individuals who detect a chemical dependency health problem in a PT or PTA take action. Without intervention, diseases have predictable courses and outcomes. The PTBC's Substance Abuse Rehabilitation Program aims to identify symptoms, intervene, and change the outcomes.

The Substance Abuse Rehabilitation Program also provides an effective alternative to the traditional disciplinary process.

WHAT PHYSICAL THERAPY CAN DO: CONDITIONS TREATED AND OUTCOMES

Physical therapy plays a vital role in restoring movement, reducing pain, and improving overall quality of life. Physical therapists in California practice in hospitals, outpatient clinics, schools, skilled nursing facilities, patients' homes, and sports performance environments across the state. Licensed physical therapists are movement experts who evaluate and treat individuals of all ages with medical conditions, illnesses, or injuries that limit their ability to function.

From post-surgical recovery to chronic pain management, physical therapy focuses on helping patients return to meaningful activities safely and efficiently.

COMMON CONDITIONS TREATED

Physical therapists treat a wide range of conditions, including:

Musculoskeletal Conditions

- Back and neck pain
- Shoulder, knee, and hip injuries
- Sprains and strains
- Arthritis
- Post-operative rehabilitation (e.g., joint replacement)

Neurological Conditions

- Stroke
- Parkinson's Disease
- Multiple sclerosis
- Spinal cord injuries

Balance and Fall Prevention

- Vestibular disorders
- Age-related balance deficits
- Fall risk reduction programs

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Sports and Orthopedic Injuries

- Ligament injuries (e.g., ACL tears)
- Tendonitis
- Overuse injuries

Chronic Pain Conditions

- Fibromyalgia
- Persistent low back pain
- Chronic joint pain

Physical therapists develop individualized treatment plans based on each patient's condition, goals, and overall health status.

TREATMENT APPROACHES

Physical therapy interventions may include:

- Therapeutic exercise to improve strength, flexibility, and endurance
- Manual therapy techniques to reduce pain and restore mobility
- Balance and gait training
- Neuromuscular re-education

- Patient education on posture, ergonomics, and injury prevention
- Home exercise programs to support continued progress

Care is evidence-based and tailored to promote safe and effective recovery.

OUTCOMES AND BENEFITS

Research supports the effectiveness of physical therapy in improving patient outcomes. Benefits may include:

- Reduced pain
- Improved mobility and flexibility
- Increased strength and stability
- Enhanced balance and coordination
- Faster recovery following injury or surgery
- Reduced need for opioids in pain management
- Improved overall function and independence

Early intervention with physical therapy can often prevent conditions from worsening and may reduce the need for more invasive treatments.

The Physical Therapy Board of California (PTBC) is committed to protecting consumers by ensuring that physical therapists and physical therapist assistants meet established standards of education, competency, and professional conduct.

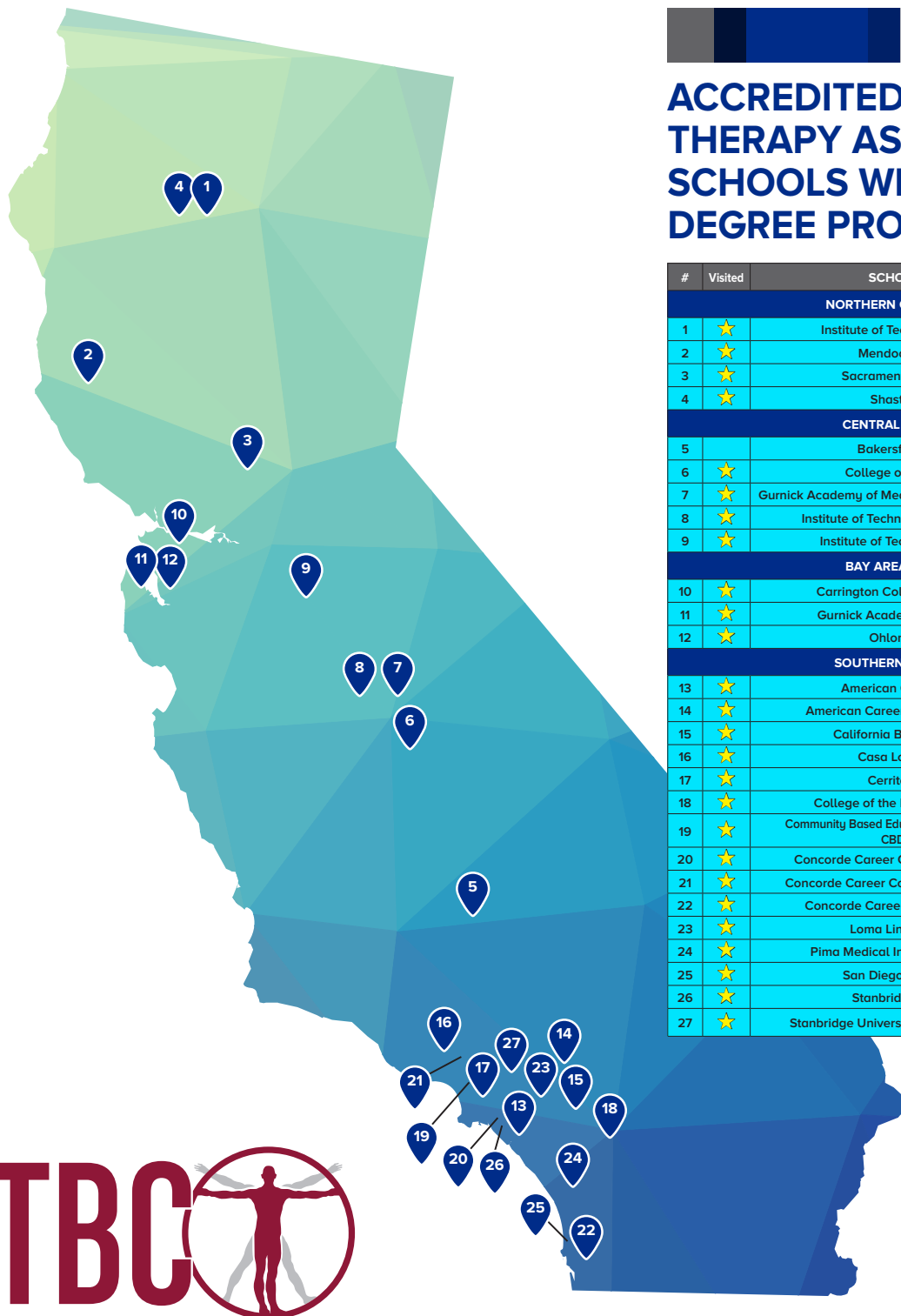

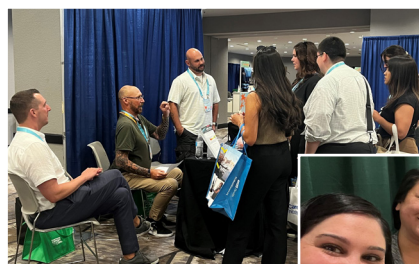

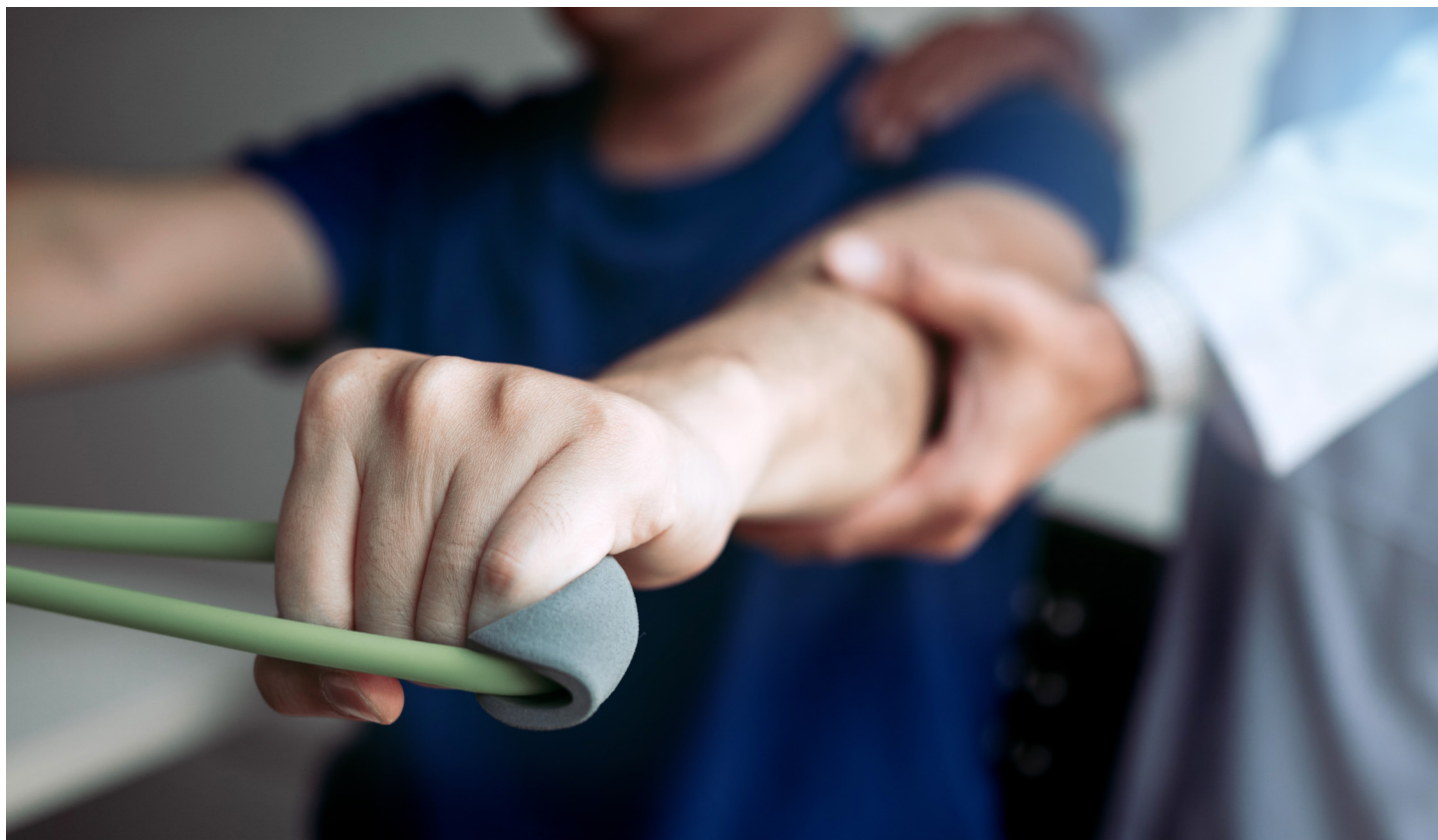

Glossary of Terms

Accusations: Charges filed against a licensee alleging violation(s) of the Physical Therapy Practice Act.

Interim Suspension Order: An order issued upon petition, suspending a licensee from all or specified part of their practice of, or assisting in the provision of, physical therapy.

Petition to Revoke Probation: Charges filed against a probationer seeking revocation of their physical therapy or physical therapy assistant license based upon violation(s) of probation.

Probationary License: Where good cause exists to deny a license, the licensing agency has the option to issue a conditional license subject to probationary terms and conditions.

Public Letter of Reprimand: In lieu of filing a formal accusation, the Board may, pursuant to B & P Code section 2660.3, upon stipulation or agreement by the licensee, issue a public letter of reprimand. If the licensee does not agree to the issuance of the letter, the Board shall not issue the letter and may proceed to file a formal accusation. A public letter of reprimand is considered disciplinary action.

Statement of Issues Filed: Charges filed against an applicant due to alleged violation(s) of the Physical Therapy Practice Act. If found to be true, the charges may result in discipline.

Surrender of License: The licensee surrenders their license to the Board, subject to acceptance of the surrendered license by the Board, and the licensee is prohibited from engaging in the practice, or assisting in the provision, of physical therapy.

Stipulated Decision: Negotiated settlements waiving court appeals.

ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS—CITATIONS



A Citation and Fine is an administrative action by which PTBC may address relatively minor violations of the Physical Therapy Practice Act that would not necessarily warrant discipline in order to protect the public. Citation and Fine Orders ARE NOT disciplinary actions but are

matters of public record. Citations remain on a licensee's file for five years and are then purged. By law, payment of a fine is considered satisfactory resolution of all violations contained in the citation.
